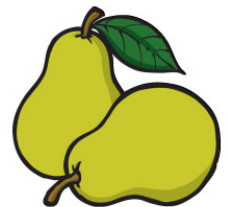
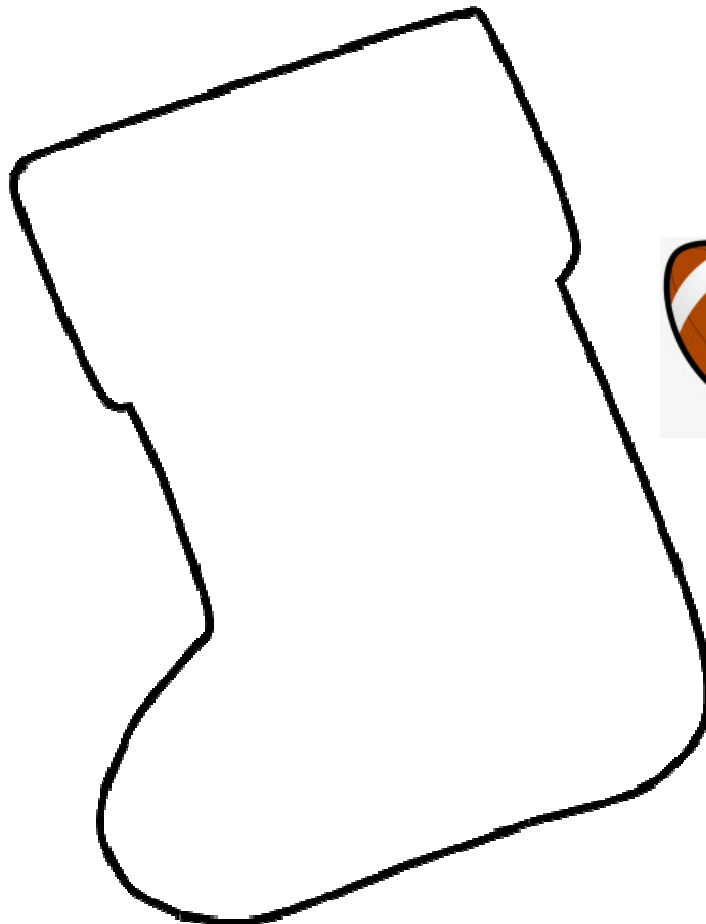
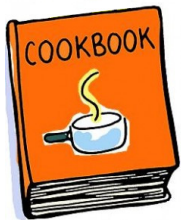
## Rudolf's Christmas Stocking
