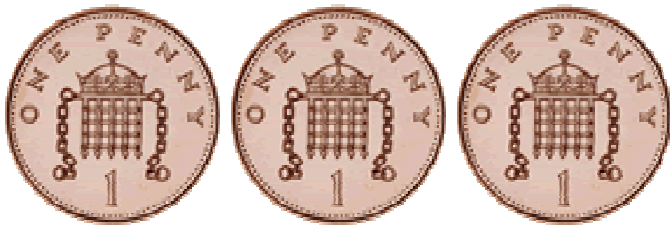
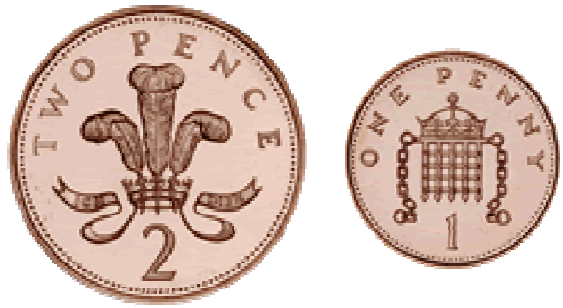


## Money Dominoes

A simple coin/money recognition matching game for 2—6 players.

- Print off the 7 sheets of cards (for best results set printer settings to **A4**), laminate, cut each page into 4 tiles, horizontally in pairs, giving 28 cards.
- Deal cards out to players, 4 or 5 each, place rest of cards in middle of the table.
- Ask players to pick up their cards and ask who has the double 3p card ( i.e. the number 3p and coins equivalent to 3p (If no one has the 3p card, ask for a 4p card)
- The next player clockwise has to match a 3p card to a 3p card from their hand with the 3p card already laid.
- Initially, it can be either coins or a or a number. Double cards are placed at right angles to the chain.
- If a player has no 3p card, they must pick a card up from the pile, this constitutes their turn.
- Play continues until one player has played all their cards and is called the winner.
