

Summer Dominoes

A simple word recognition matching game for 2—6 players.

Print off the 7 sheets of cards (for best results set printer settings to **A4**). Laminate, and cut each page into 4 tiles, horizontally in pairs, giving 28 cards.

Deal cards out to players (4 or 5 each) and place rest of cards in middle of the table.

Ask players to pick up their cards and ask who has the double sun hat card (i.e. a picture of a sun hat and the word **sun hat** (If no one has that card, ask who has the double bucket and spade card.).

The next player clockwise has to match a sun hat card from their hand with the sun hat card laid.

Initially, it can be either a picture or a word.

Double cards are placed at right angles to the chain.

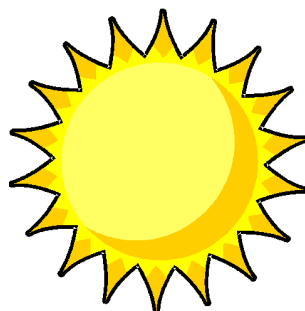
If a player has no sun hat card, they must pick a card up from the pile, this constitutes their turn.

Play continues until one player has played all their cards and is called the winner.



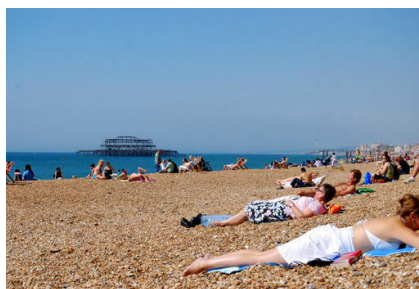

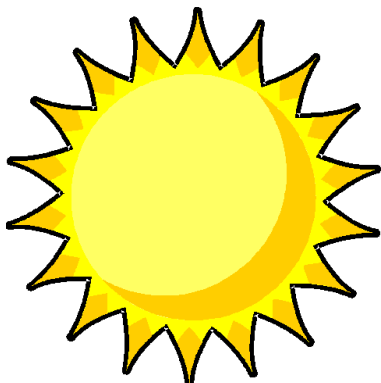

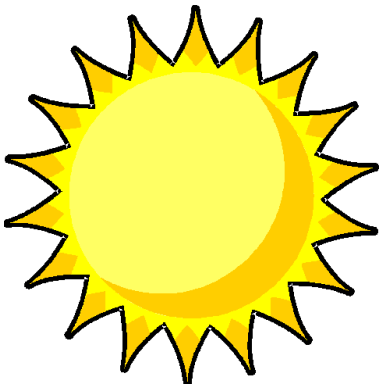
