


## Hongbao Envelopes

## Create a Mnemonic

Each year the Chinese calendar has an animal to represent it. The qualities and characteristics of each animal are said to reflect the nature of the year. The twelve animals are in a sequence and are repeated after a 12 year cycle. It would be good to find a way to remember them all. One way would be to devise a **mnemonic**. This is a technique where you think of a memorable sentence in which each word starts with the first letter of each word to be remembered. One example is the way to remember the colours of the rainbow - Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue, Indigo, Violet can become Richard Of York Gave Battle In Vain.
