




<u>Verbs</u>

It is your job to colour the baubles that contain verbs.




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
<u>Adjectives</u>


Adjectives are describing words. They describe **nouns** (the names of things or places).



<u>Plurals</u>


To make a noun **plural** (more than one) sometimes you add **s** or **es**.
